## Lincoln Man Pleads Guilty to Federal Drug Charges

Bangor, Maine: United States Attorney Paula D. Silsby announced that **Raymond Davis**, 48, formerly of Lincoln, Maine, now of Jupiter, Florida, pled guilty on December 15, 2008, in U.S. District Court in Bangor, Maine, to conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute cocaine. Davis faces a possible sentence of at least 10 years up to life imprisonment, and a fine of not more than \$4,000,000.

Court records reveal that between January 2002 and June 2005, Davis conspired with others to possess with the intent to distribute 5 kilograms or more of cocaine, 50 grams or more of cocaine base and oxycodone. While residing in Lincoln, Davis was a distributor and transporter of cocaine. Davis would drive from Maine to Florida, obtain cocaine from another co-conspirator and return to Maine with the drugs. Davis concealed the cocaine at an area storage unit he had rented. The co-conspirator and others would travel to Maine and distribute the cocaine with Davis. After Davis moved to Florida and lived and worked with his co-conspirator. Two other co-conspirators traveled to Florida to obtain cocaine from the co-conspirator, and Davis helped them hide the cocaine in the vehicle they were driving

United States Attorney Silsby praised the investigation conducted by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration.
