NEWS RELEASE SUMMARY - February 13, 2009

United States Attorney Karen P. Hewitt announced that Kristopher Kinman was sentenced today in U.S. District Court in San Diego by the Honorable Judge Jeffrey T. Miller to serve 144 months in custody, based on his conviction for distribution of methamphetamine. Judge Miller also ordered that Kinman serve a 5-year term of supervised release following his release from prison. According to court records, Kinman entered a guilty plea to two counts of distribution of five grams or more of pure methamphetamine. As part of his guilty plea, Kinman admitted that he also participated in the distribution of an additional 69 grams of pure methamphetamine.
