I want to provide you with another status update regarding your November 3, 2005, Request for Correction submitted under the Environmental Protection Agency's Information Quality Guidelines. These guidelines state that EPA's goal is to respond to each request within 90 days of receipt, either by providing a decision on the request or if the request will require more than 90 days to resolve, informing the requestor that more time is required.

EPA's draft response to your request has been undergoing review, as we stated in our October 31, 2006, letter, but again we find that additional time will be necessary to complete the steps necessary to finalize that response. We anticipate that a response will be forwarded to you within 90 days, although we continue to expect that it will be earlier than that.
