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GYPSUM IN OCTOBER 2008

Producers mined 1.0 million metric tons (Mt) of gypsum in October 2008 (table 1). Output was down slightly from September 2008 and 50% less than that of October 2007. The significant decrease between 2007 and 2008 is likely the result of improved data analysis, not an actual decline in production, and should be interpreted within this context. Synthetic gypsum production was 687,000 metric tons (t) in October 2008 (table 1), which was 5% less than that of September 2008 and 3% less than that of October 2007. Both mined and synthetic gypsum are used as raw material for wallboard. The wallboard industry is the leading domestic consumer of gypsum. During October 2008, synthetic gypsum accounted for about 29% of the 2.4-Mt total supply of gypsum in the United States. Sales of uncalcined gypsum in October 2008, mainly for portland cement manufacture and for agricultural uses, were 561,000 t (table 2), 7% less than those of September 2008 and 41% more than those of October 2007.

Output of calcined gypsum for October 2008 (table 1) was 1.51 Mt, unchanged from September 2008 and 18% less than that of October 2007. Sales of board products (table 2) were approximately 186 million square meters (2.01 billion square feet), slightly less than those of September 2008 and 24% less than those of October 2007.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, imports of crude gypsum in October 2008 were 645,000 t (table 3), 46% more than those of September 2008 and 26% less than those of October 2007. The United States imported crude gypsum from four countries in October 2008. Of these imports, Canada accounted for 62%, followed by Mexico with 38%. Imports from Spain and the United Kingdom were negligible.

Gypsum wallboard imports for October 2008 were 33,300 t, equivalent to 3.70 million square meters (40 million square feet). These imports were 21% more than those of September 2008 and 17% more than those of October 2007. The United States imported wallboard products from two countries in October 2008. Canada accounted for 55% of these imports, followed by Mexico with 45%. Wallboard exports to 33 countries and territories in October 2008 were 8,900 t, equivalent to 984,000 square meters (10.6 million square feet). These exports were about 15% more than those of September 2008 and 5% more than those of October 2007. Most wallboard exports were shipped to 22 western hemisphere countries, with Mexico accounting for 25%, followed by Canada with 21%, and the United Arab Emirates with 10%.

All percentages in this report were computed based on unrounded data.
