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GYPSUM IN DECEMBER 2008

Producers mined 686,000 metric tons (t) of gypsum in December 2008 (table 1). Output decreased 10% from November 2008 and was 28% less than that of the revised data for December 2007. Synthetic gypsum production was 570,000 t in December 2008 (table 1), which was 14% more than that of November 2008 and slightly more than that of December 2007. Both mined and synthetic gypsum are used as raw material for wallboard. The wallboard industry is the leading domestic consumer of gypsum. During December 2008, synthetic gypsum accounted for about 31% of the 1.8 million-metric-ton (Mt) total supply of gypsum in the United States. Sales of uncalcined gypsum in December 2008, mainly for portland cement manufacture and for agricultural uses, were 420,000 t (table 2), 18% less than those of November 2008 and 4% more than those of December 2007.

Output of calcined gypsum for December 2008 (table 1) was 1.2 Mt, 8% more than November 2008 and 20% less than that of December 2007. Sales of board products (table 2) were approximately 153 million square meters (1.65 billion square feet), an increase of 9% from those of November 2008 and 13% less than those of December 2007.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, imports of crude gypsum in December 2008 were 571,000 t (table 3), 27% more than those of November 2008 and 21% less than those of

December 2007. The United States imported crude gypsum from four countries in December 2008. Of these imports, Canada accounted for 57%, followed by Mexico with 27%, Spain with 14%, and Jamaica with 1%.

Gypsum wallboard imports for December 2008 were 16,900 t, equivalent to 1.88 million square meters (20 million square feet). These imports were 24% less than those of November 2008 and 3% more than those of December 2007. The United States imported wallboard products from four countries in December 2008. Canada accounted for 49% of these imports, followed by Mexico with 47%, and China with 4%. Imports from the United Kingdom were negligible. Wallboard exports to 23 countries and territories in December 2008 were 5.400 t, equivalent to 606.000 square meters (6.5) million square feet). These exports were down slightly from those of November 2008 and 13% less than those of December 2007. Most wallboard exports were shipped to 18 western hemisphere countries, with Mexico accounting for 28%, followed by Canada with 25%, Singapore with 12%, the Dominican Republic with 10%, and the Bahamas with 7%.

All percentages in this report were computed based on unrounded data.
