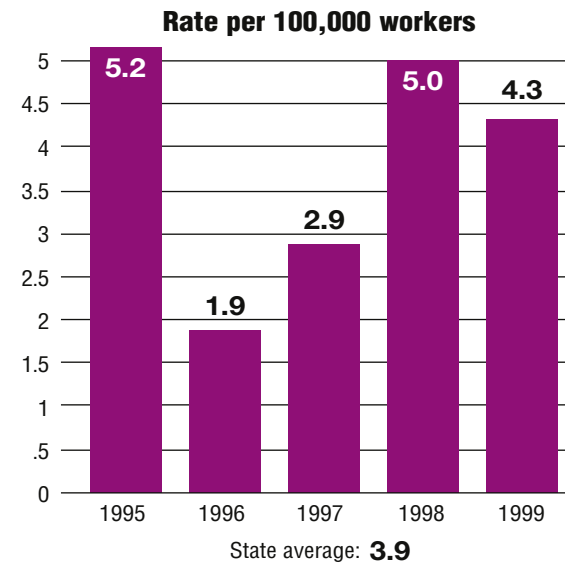

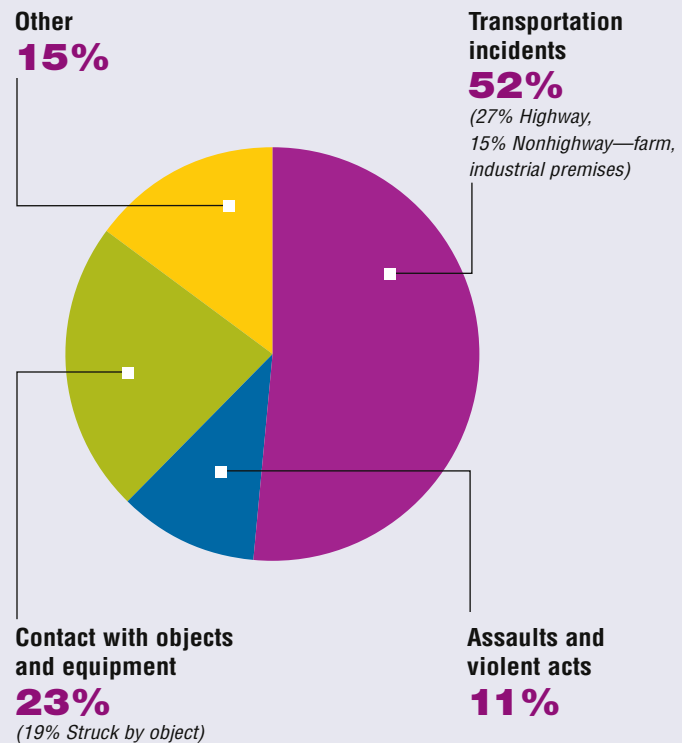

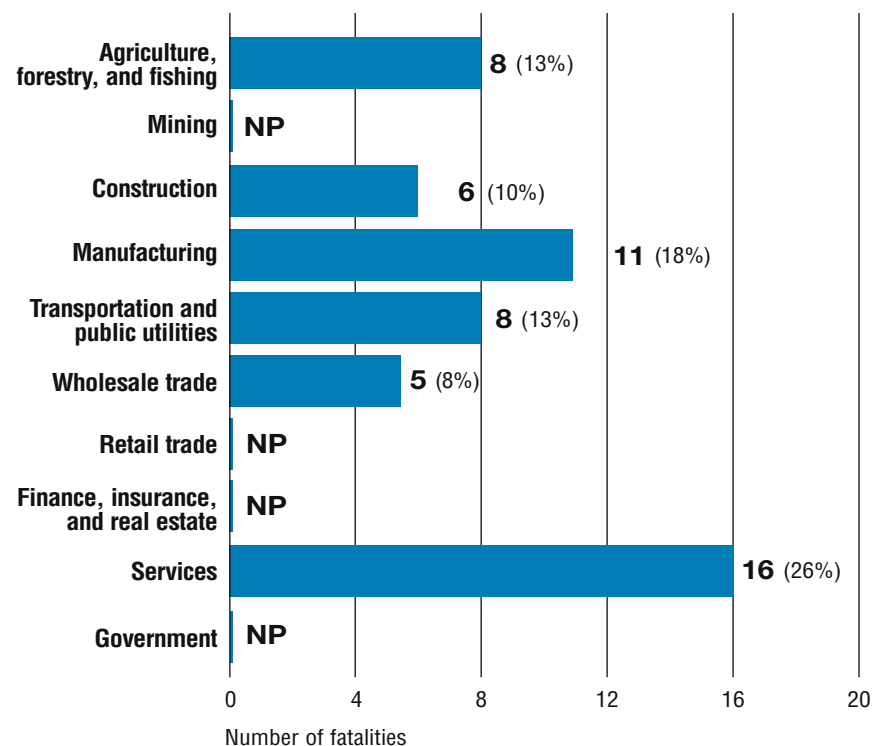


OCCUPATIONS WITH THE MOST FATALITIES
