<u>Notice of Modified Exchange Proposal</u> <u>Proposed Exchange of Properties in Rio Grande and Saguache Counties, Colorado</u> <u>Serial No. COC-68881</u>

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) hereby gives Notice that the exchange proposal previously published in the <u>Valley Courier</u> weekly from December 20, 2007, to January 9, 2008, is being modified. The exchange proposal included ten parcels of federal lands totaling approximately 2,693 acres in Rio Grande County to acquire up to 189.8 acre-feet of water annually from the Anderson Ditch. Parcels C, E, H, and I described in the initial Notice of Exchange Proposal will not be considered any further and have been deleted from the exchange. The deleted parcels in Rio Grande County have been replaced by four federal parcels located in Saguache County. The revised exchange proposal totals approximately 2,574 acres in ten parcels.

The federal lands in the revised exchange proposal are listed below by parcel, legal description, and parcel acreage. Parcels A and B have been redescribed to conform to the resurvey plat. The new parcels in Saguache County are Parcels K, L, M, and N.

Parcels K, L, M, and N will be segregated from appropriation under the public land laws for a period of five years upon publication of this Notice. The BLM proposes to convey the above listed federal lands to Sun Peaks land Company, LLC, subject to valid existing rights.

In exchange for the above-described federal lands, Sun Peaks Land Company, LLC, will convey 189.8 acre-feet of water rights to BLM as described in the original Notice of Exchange Proposal.

The properties in the exchange proposal will be appraised in accordance with federal regulations and federal appraisal standards. The values of the federal and non-federal properties must be equal, or capable of being equalized, in order for the exchange to be approved. Lands may be deleted from the exchange in order to equalize values.

In order to be considered in the environmental analysis of the proposed exchange, comments must be in writing to the Interdisciplinary Team Leader and received within 45 days of the initial publication of this Notice in the <u>Valley Courier</u>.
