Lewistown, MT----The Bureau of Land Management encourages everyone interested in forestry and fuels projects on public lands in the Judith and Moccasin Mountains to attend a field trip in the Judith Mountains on Wednesday, September 26th, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.

Participants should travel approximately 1 mile past the Maiden School in lower Maiden Canyon and meet at the pull off leading from the county road. The pull off will be marked and BLM staff will be parked at the site. Everyone should be dressed to walk in the woods.

The field trip will build upon discussions held at our June meeting and continue collaborative efforts concerning implementation of forestry and fuels projects on these public lands. Newcomers are welcome.

During this meeting, BLM foresters Bruce Reid and Brad Eckert will discuss a specific proposed treatment area and continue discussions regarding silvicultural prescriptions for the area around Camp Maiden.
