WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 8 of the Act of June 26, 1934 (48 Stat. 1269), entitled "An Act To stop injury to the public grazing lands by preventing overgrazing and soil deterioration, to provide for their orderly use, improvement, and development, to stabilize the livestock industry dependent upon the public range, and for other purposes," as amended by Section 3 of the Act of June 26, 1936 (49 Stat. 1976), and the Act of June 19, 1948 (62 Stat. 533), the State of Montana, in exchange for certain other lands situated in said State, has selected the following described tracts of land:

The areas described aggregate 16,552.53 acres, according to the Official  
Plats of the Surveys of the said Lands, on file in the Bureau of Land Management:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the  
premises, and in conformity with the said Acts of Congress, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED

and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT unto the said State of Montana, in fee simple, the tracts of land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said State of Montana, and to its assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right-of-way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

Reserving, also, to the United States, all coal, oil and gas in the lands so granted, together with the right to prospect for, mine, and remove the same as authorized by the provisions of said Section 8 as amended as aforesaid.
