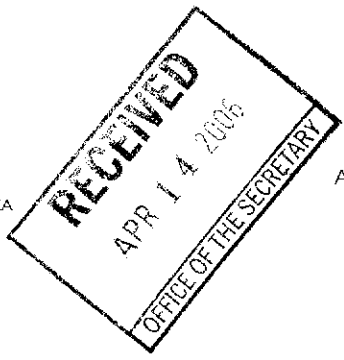

Dear Ms. Morris:

The Los Angeles City Employees' Retirement System (LACERS) administers a \$9.4 billion defined benefit public pension plan serving 42,168 active and retired members and their beneficiaries. LACERS' Corporate Governance Committee strongly supports greater disclosure of Executive Compensation and the added investor protections proposed by the SEC.

LACERS believes that improving alignment of interests between shareowners and corporate management produces superior investment returns. As such, the LACERS Corporate Governance Committee focuses a high level of attention and care towards promoting sound corporate governance practices. The Committee is charged with reviewing, monitoring, discussing, and developing action-oriented recommendations focused in this arena.

The Committee believes that the Council of institutional investors' SEC Issues Briefing Book, dated March 30, 2006, best reflects the concerns, objectives, and solutions in this topic. The Committee strongly supports your concepts of a Compensation Discussion and Analysis, the three primary categories of tables, and the supplemental narrative disclosures.
