
We need your ideas!

We need your comments to help us define the issues and alternatives as we evaluate the environmental impacts of a proposal to build transmission facilities in Trinity County, Calif. The proposed project involves removing about 5.3 miles of 12-kV distribution line and constructing and operating about 16 miles of new 60-kV transmission line, a tap structure and associated equipment as well as a new switchyard.

Western will host two public meetings to help define the scope of the Trinity Public Utility District Direct Interconnection Project Environmental Impact Statement. Both meeting locations are handicapped accessible. Comments will be accepted until July 20.
