PROCLAMATION  
BY THE  
GOVERNOR

TO THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, The year 2004 marks the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Watershed Protection and Flood Prevention Act PL-566; and

WHEREAS, In Kansas, 770 dams have been constructed so far through the Federal Program; and

WHEREAS, These dams bring an estimated \$30.5 million of annual benefits to Kansas; and

WHEREAS, These dams are located in 38 Kansas counties and protect nearly 25 percent of the land area of Kansas;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KATHLEEN SEBELIUS, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF KANSAS, do hereby proclaim and designate August 4, 2004, as

*The 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Federal PL566 Watershed  
Protection and Flood Prevention Program*

in Kansas and urge all citizens to join in this important observance.
