

Discuss septic system issues with others from around the country.

Septic systems treat and disperse relatively small volumes of wastewater from individual or small numbers of homes and commercial buildings. Septic systems are regulated by state, tribal, and local authorities. EPA provides inforrmation to homeowners and assistance to state and local governments to improve the management of septic systems to prevent failures that could harm human health and water quality.

Some septic systems are regulated by EPA if they receive industrial or commercial wastes and/or they have the capacity to serve 20 or more people. More information about septic systems regulated by EPA.
