The mission of the National Park Service is to promote and regulate the use of federal areas known as National Parks. We conserve the scenery and the natural and historic objects and wildlife within. CANAVERAL NATIONAL SEASHORE

Canaveral National Seashore is administered by the U.S. Department of the Interior, National Park Service. It is one of 389 National Parks and one of 10 National Seashores in the United States.

Canaveral National Seashore was established in 1975, “to preserve and protect the outstanding natural, scenic, scientific, ecologic, and historic values of certain lands, shorelines, and waters of the State of Florida, and to provide for the public outdoor recreation use and enjoyment of the same...”
