Journey with a National Park Ranger on a visit to the undisturbed beaches to watch a loggerhead sea turtle nesting. The program will take place in the North District New Smyrna Beach and the South District Titusville. The fee for this program is \$14.00 per person ages 16 and above, 15 and under are free. Children must be 8 years old to participate. Turtle Watch programs give park visitors an opportunity to learn about sea turtles and the role that the National Park Service plays in their conservation.
