Q: What should I do if I find hazardous waste along the beach?

A: Don't Touch It! Contact the ranger at the entrance station of the park and notify them of where you found the item.

Occasionally visitors find hazardous waste such as oil drums, containers with suspicious materials, or medical waste (including syringes), on the beach. Unfortunately, beaches across the world experience varying levels of trash and debris that washes up along the shoreline, including hazardous materials.
