Julie Herendeen and I talked with Will Poole of Microsoft today. He is the 2 week old Director of Business Development in the Internet division - reports to Brad Chase who reports to Brad Silverberg.

He advised us that Paul Maritz has written a letter to Rick listing all open issues between Microsoft and Netscape (one of which will be the scripting license) where they feel both parties could be more cooperative. He wouldn't elaborate on specifics, but they are unwillingly to keep the Win 95 scripting license as a separate issue. We should be expecting the letter this Thursday or Friday.

Will also said he would put a call into Mike to discuss things further once Netscape has received the letter.
