here is two tables summarizing the latest on IE share from all methodologies. the first table is overall share where we are continuing to see a solid increase. share based on hits and calldowns are pretty close; 48% for calldowns, and 45% for hits to top sites.

the next table breaks down share for Home, Work and Win 32. we are share leaders in the home segment and in the Win 32 segment; while still lagging in the corp. segment. (caveat; this is based on calldowns to a relatively small N; and there might be a +/- 5% or so sampling error associated with this estimate)
