Dear Educators:

Make a difference in your students' experience. Take a combined field trip to the San Juan Bautista segment of the Juan Bautista de Anza National Historic Trail (Anza Trail) and San Juan Bautista State Historic Park (SHP).

The Anza Trail 2008 Teacher-Ranger-Teacher summer staff has developed exciting self-guided education materials in partnership with San Juan Bautista SHP for 4<sup>th</sup> grade and High School classes. The on-site materials are tied to the California State and National Standards. These unique curriculum-based lesson plans use both the trail and the park as an outdoor classroom. Students connect with California's rich historic past, as well as gain valuable knowledge and skills in making informed decisions concerning the environment.

There are three historic sites to visit in San Juan Bautista, California:

The Anza Trail self-guided curriculum-based education materials are reserved on a first come, first served basis. Once your reservation is made, you will receive information about accessing the education materials for your trail walk. If you chose to tour the San Juan Bautista SHP, enhance your site visit with additional educational programs (fees) or lead your own class free of charge with a reservation. The Mission charges a tour fee.

In order to ensure program success and the best possible experience for your students, we require a 1-to-5 ratio of adults to students with a 40 person limit per school visit. This is for trail safety and to lessen the impact on the historic buildings.
