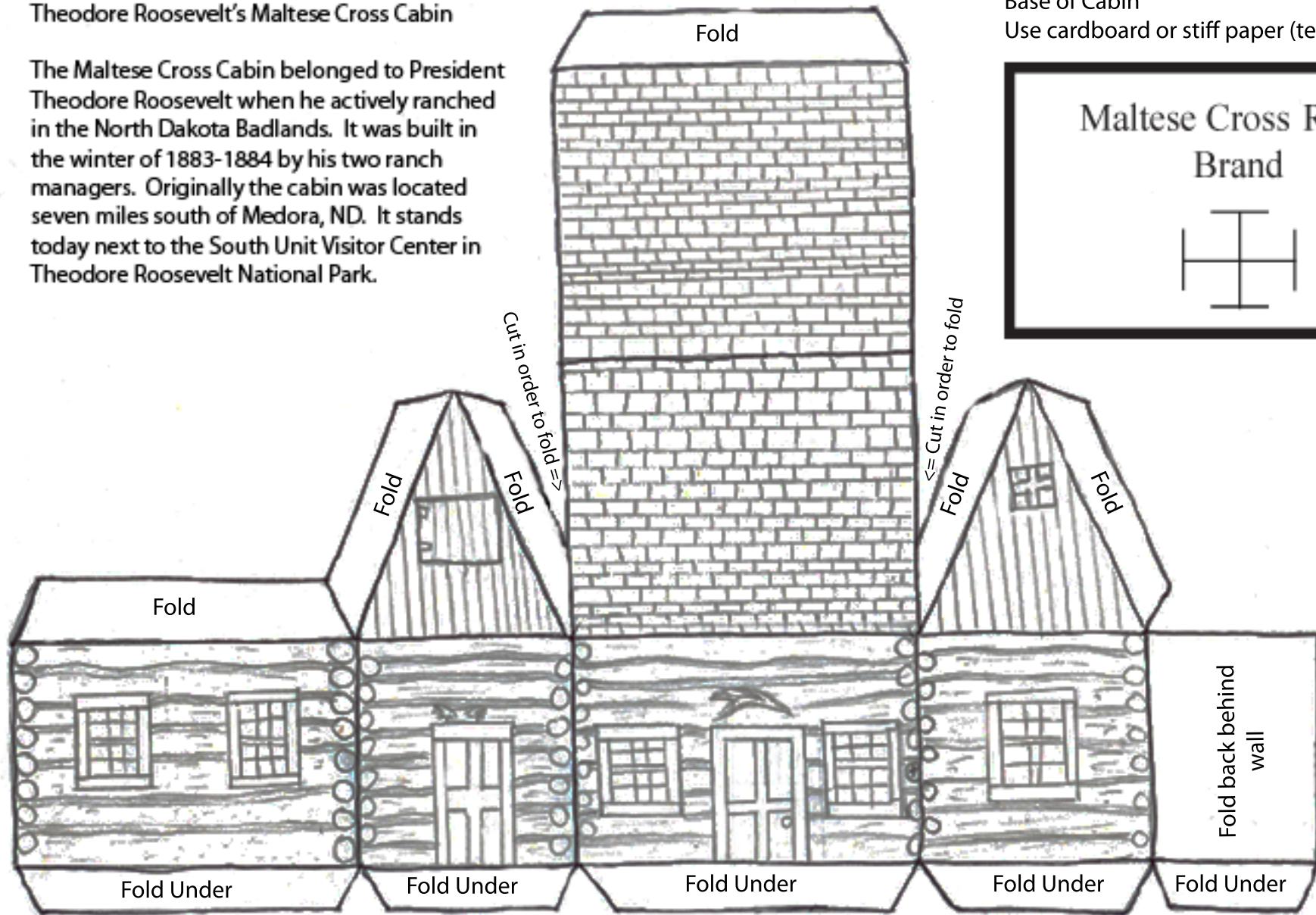
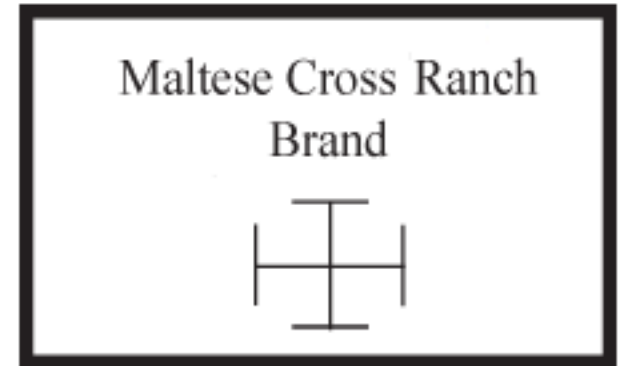


Theodore Roosevelt's Maltese Cross Cabin

The Maltese Cross Cabin belonged to President Theodore Roosevelt when he actively ranched in the North Dakota Badlands. It was built in the winter of 1883-1884 by his two ranch managers. Originally the cabin was located seven miles south of Medora, ND. It stands today next to the South Unit Visitor Center in Theodore Roosevelt National Park.
