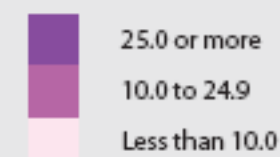


# Percentage of Coastal County Housing Units That Were Seasonal : 2000

In 2000, seasonal housing represented a majority of all housing units in 7 coastal counties: Hamilton, NY (65.4), Lake County, MI (61.0), Lake and Peninsula Borough, AK (58.3), Nantucket County, MA (56.1), Dukes County, MA (53.9), Keweenaw County, MI (50.5), and Dare County, NC (50.1).

In 2000, seasonal housing represented 25.0 percent or more of all housing units in 64 counties. These 64 counties often had relatively small populations; Barnstable County, MA (2000 population: 222,230) was the most populous.
