## **Avalanche Danger**

The Bridger, Gallatin and Madison Ranges, and the Lionhead area near West Yellowstone: **CONSIDERABLE** avalanche danger exists on any wind loaded slope. Other slopes have a **MODERATE** avalanche danger. The mountains around Cooke City and the Washburn Range: wind loaded slopes have **HIGH** avalanche danger. Non wind loaded slopes have a **CONSIDERABLE** avalanche danger.

## **Weather Forecast**

**Today:** A 40 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 31, low around 15. Wind chill values as low as zero. New snow accumulation of 2 to 4 inches possible.

**Monday:** Snow likely, mainly before 11am. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 31, low around 11. West wind between 11 and 15 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches possible.

**Tuesday:** A 20 percent chance of snow. Partly cloudy, with a high near 29, low around 11.

**Wednesday:** A 20 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 33, low around 8.

**Thursday:** Mostly sunny, with a high near 29, low around 13.
