The Gallatin and Madison Ranges, the Lionhead area near West Yellowstone, the mountains around Cooke City and the Washburn Range: Human triggered avalanches are possible and the danger is rated [MODERATE](#).. The Bridger Range: the avalanche danger is rated [MODERATE](#) on slopes steeper than 35 degrees and [LOW](#) everywhere else.

Weather Forecast Hazardous weather outlook for western and central Wyoming with a system expected to affect the area Sunday night and Monday with the potential to bring another round of moderate snow amounts.

Sunday: A 20 percent chance of snow after 11am. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 32, low around 15. Wind chill values as low as -5. Chance of snow overnight 40%

Monday: A 50 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 30, low around 10.

Tuesday: A 30 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 24, low around 8.

Wednesday: A chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 24, low around 7.
