**New Year's Day:** Snow and areas of blowing snow. High near 24, low around 19. Breezy, with gusts up to 37 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. Total daytime snow accumulation of 1 to 2 inches possible.

**Friday:** Snow and areas of blowing snow. High near 27, low around 8. Windy, with gusts as high as 45 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New snow accumulation of 2 to 4 inches possible.

**Saturday:** A 30 percent chance of snow, mainly before 11am. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 14, low around -1.

**Sunday:** Partly sunny, with a high near 17, low around 6.

**Monday:** A chance of snow. Cloudy, with a high near 16, low around 9.
