### **AVALANCHE DANGER**

The avalanche danger remains **HIGH** on all slopes for the mountains around Cooke City and the Washburn Range in northern Yellowstone National Park. The snowpack is very unstable. Natural and human triggered avalanches are likely.

### **Weather Forecast**

#### **Today**

Highs 5 to 11. Lows -3 to -9. Wind chill readings -29 to -39.

#### **Monday and Tuesday**

70 percent chance of snow. Accumulation of 4 to 8 inches. Highs 10 to 16. Lows 7 to 13. Wind chill readings -27 to -37.

#### **Wednesday**

60 percent chance of snow. Highs 23 to 29. Lows 13 to 19.

#### **Thursday**

70 percent chance of snow. Highs 23 to 29. Lows 12 to 18.

#### **Friday and Saturday**

50 percent chance of snow. Highs 16 to 22. Lows 4 to 10.
