### **Weather Forecast Winter Storm Watch for Saturday afternoon through Sunday morning for heavy snowfall in central and western Wyoming**

**Saturday:** Snow likely, mainly after 11am. High near 25, low around 5. Wind chill values as low as -10.. Chance of precipitation is 70%. New snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches possible.

**Sunday:** Snow likely. Cloudy and cold, with a high near 10, low around -9. Wind chill values as low as -10. Chance of precipitation is 70%.

**Monday:** A 20 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 12, low around -2.

**Tuesday:** Partly sunny, with a high near 18, low around 8.
