TUESDAY THROUGH SUNDAY - SIGNIFICANT SNOWFALL IS POSSIBLE OVER WESTERN AND CENTRAL WYOMING THURSDAY AND FRIDAY AS ANOTHER STRONG GULF OF ALASKA STORM SYSTEM TRACKS SLOWLY THROUGH THE ROCKIES. ANOTHER ARCTIC BLAST OF COLD AIR AND LIGHT SNOW IS EXPECTED TO MOVE SOUTH ACROSS WESTERN AND CENTRAL WYOMING FRIDAY NIGHT AND SATURDAY WITH BITTER COLD TEMPERATURES REMAINING THROUGH SUNDAY.

Tuesday: A 40 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 11, low around -7. Wind chill values as low as -25. West southwest wind between 5 and 8 mph. New snow accumulation of less than one inch possible during the day, with additional 1-2 inches over night.

Wednesday: A 30 percent chance of snow, mainly after 11am. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 13, low around -3. Wind chill values as low as -26. South southwest wind between 10 and 14 mph.

Thursday: A 40 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 16, low around -3.

Friday: A chance of snow. Cloudy and cold, with a high near 10, low around -16.

Saturday: A chance of snow. Cloudy and cold, with a high near 2, low around -14.
