Danger for both the Cooke City and West Yellowstone areas is considered HIGH on all wind loaded slopes and CONSIDERABLE on all non-wind loaded slopes.

Weather Forecast

Winter weather advisory in effect from 5am to 5pm – snowfall of 8-14 inches in higher terrain of Yellowstone, with 3-6 inches in lower elevations, gusty southwest winds will cause blowing and drifting.

Today: Snow likely. Cloudy, with a high near 20, low around 20. Wind chill values as low as -5. Breezy, with a south southwest wind between 21 and 23 mph, with gusts as high as 32 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%.

Monday: Snow, mainly after 11am. High near 28, low around 5. Breezy, with a southwest wind between 22 and 25 mph, with gusts as high as 36 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%.

Tuesday and Wednesday: A 50 percent chance of snow. Cloudy, with a high near 20, low around 6.

New Year's Day: A chance of snow. Cloudy, with a high near 20, low around 6.

Friday: A chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 22.
