NMFS Announces Final Atlantic Bluefin Tuna Quotas and Effort Controls for the 2007 Fishing Year

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) announces the final rule to set the 2007 fishing year quotas for the Atlantic bluefin tuna (BFT) fishery and effort controls, based on the 2006 quota recommended for the United States by the International Commission for the Conservation of Atlantic tunas (ICCAT). The final quota specifications are effective through December 31, 2007, due to the shift to a *calendar year* fishing year beginning January 1, 2008.

NMFS establishes the following General category restricted fishing days: all Saturdays and Sundays from November 17, 2007 through December 31, 2007, plus November 22, 2007, and December 25, 2007, provided the fishery remains open. NMFS also establishes General category retention limits and Angling category retention limits for the 2007 fishing year, with duration noted, as follows:

Quota Category	Retention Limit (per <u>vessel</u> per day/trip)	Duration
General	3 large medium/giant BFT (measuring 73" or greater)	Present through August 31, 2007*
Angling	1 school BFT (measuring 27-<47") AND 2 large school/small medium BFT (measuring 47-<73")	Present through December 31, 2007

Additional actions (adjustments) may be taken for subsequent time periods, as necessary.
