Dates & Times: Saturday 10/18 - Sunday, 10/26, 9:00 am- 6:00 pm

Examples of materials to be collected include:

- batteries
- paint & workshop supplies
- cleaning & pool supplies
- lawn & garden products
- indoor pesticides & thermometers
- automotive products
- and other hazardous chemicals

We CANNOT accept:

- animal manure/carcasses
- human waste or other biological waste
- sharps/needles
- white goods (appliances)
- munitions or explosives
- electronic waste
- spoiled food/mold damaged items
- tires, furniture and general trash

- ▶ Clearly mark containers before dropping off.
- ▶ Place leaking containers in plastic bags to prevent spills.
- ▶ Household hazardous items may contain materials that should never be dumped, poured down drains or into streets.
