Con-way Freight

Fleet: 8,400 tractors

EPA SmartWay partner since: 2006

- Speed reduction 65 to 62 mph in 2008
- Low profile tires improve rolling resistance and reduce weight
- Engines/drive train specs tuned for optimal fuel economy
- Idling monitors set to 3 minutes
- Aerodynamic fairings for tractors, reduce resistance
- Trailer weight reduced
- Exclusively use remanufactured trailers reduced waste stream



Con-way Freight — 2007 Results

- Diesel fuel savings: 3,594,377 gallons (3.8 percent)
- Carbon dioxide emission reduction: 601,928 tons
- Particulate matter emission reduction: 32.09 tons
- Nitrogen oxide emission reduction: 1,184 tons
- SmartWay Shipper Index Factor: 1.25 highest attainable score



Con-way Truckload

Fleet: 2,700 tractors

SmartWay partner since: 2005

- Speed reduction 70 to 65 mph in 2008
- 100 percent of tractors converted to single wide-base tires (40 percent of trailers by end of 2008)
- Purchase of SmartWay-approved and CARB-certifiable engines
- Truck spec weight lowered by 670 pounds, saving 11,400 gallons of diesel fuel each year
- No-idle designated parking at selected terminals
- Aerodynamic considerations in tractor and trailer purchases



Con-way Truckload — 2007 Results

- Diesel fuel savings: 2,575,475 gallons
- Carbon dioxide emission reduction: 295,712 tons
- Particulate matter emission reduction: 17.9 tons
- Nitrogen oxide emission reduction: 670 tons
- SmartWay Shipper Index Factor: 1.25 highest attainable score
- SmartWay Excellence Award winner 2006 and 2007



Menlo Worldwide Logistics

Fleet: Contract carriers only

SmartWay partner since: 2007

- SmartWay compliance key evaluation criteria for carrier selection
- Encourages SmartWay compliance in existing carriers
- 85 percent of network miles run by SmartWay-approved carriers
- Implementing no-idling policy at distribution centers
