**DECISION AND ORDER**

This proceeding arose under the standards of conduct provisions of the Civil Service Reform Act of 1978, 5 U.S.C. 7120, and the implementing regulations, 29 CFR Parts 457-459, as a result of a complaint alleging that 29 CFR § 458.29 was violated when respondent prohibited eligible voters from casting meaningful ballots in an officer election. The complainant subsequently filed a joint motion for withdrawal of complaint and dismissal of case with Administrative Law Judge Christine M. Moore. On February 26, 1996, the Administrative Law Judge issued an Order of Dismissal, which constitutes her Recommended Decision and Order pursuant to 29 CFR §458.70.


Since no exceptions have been filed, pursuant to 29 CFR § 458.91 the Recommended Decision and Order, styled Order of Dismissal, is adopted and incorporated hereto without discussion.

**ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, THAT, this case be, and it hereby is, dismissed.
