Florida	Florida Dept. of Law Enforcement for all firearms, except licensees may contact the FBI for certain pawn transactions
Iowa	Permit POC for handguns FBI – long guns
Maryland	Maryland State Police – handguns and assault weapons FBI – long guns and pawn redemptions
Michigan	Permit POC for handguns FBI – long guns

Nebraska	Permit POC for handguns FBI – long guns
New Hampshire	New Hampshire Department of Safety for handguns FBI – long guns
North Carolina	Permit POC for handguns FBI – long guns
Washington	Chief law enforcement officer for handguns without CPL FBI - for handguns with CPL FBI – long guns
Wisconsin	Wisconsin Department of Justice for handguns FBI – long guns
