Focus: Mental Health

All data presented are most recent available.

- More than 1 in 20 Americans aged 12 and over currently have depression (National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey, 2005-2006).
- Over 33,000 suicides occurred in 2006; that's about 11 deaths per 100,000 population (<u>National Vital Statistics</u> <u>System</u>, 2006).
- ◆ Of visits to physician offices for chronic conditions, **9.5% were for depression** in 2006, up from 7.5% in 1996 (National Ambulatory Medical Care Survey, 2006).
- Over 25 million visits to physician offices in 2006 were made to doctors who specialized in psychiatry (<u>National</u> <u>Ambulatory Medical Care Survey</u>, 2006).
- ♦ About 41.6 million visits to physician offices in 2006 resulted in a diagnosis of a mental disorder (National Ambulatory Medical Care Survey, 2006).

- In 2006, over 2.4 million hospital discharges had a principal diagnosis of mental disorders, including schizophrenia or a major depressive disorder (<u>National Hospital Discharge</u> <u>Survey</u>, 2006).
- About 4.3 million emergency room visits (3.6% of all visits) resulted in a diagnosis of a mental disorder (<u>National</u> <u>Hospital Ambulatory Medical Care</u> <u>Survey</u>, 2006).
- ♦ About **98 million antidepressants** were prescribed at ambulatory care visits in 2006 (that's 4.2 per every 100 drug mentions). Primary care physicians prescribed over 45.7% of antidepressants, whereas medical specialty physicians prescribed 35.9% (National Ambulatory Medical Care Survey, 2006).
- Of 1.5 million nursing home residents, 244,000 have a mental disorder (<u>National</u> <u>Nursing Home Survey</u>, 2004).
