<prognosis>	Information specific to the prognosis of this disorder
<research>	Information specific to general research for this disorder
<researchLink>	A direct link to PubMed, displaying publications specific to this disorder
<medlineplusLink>	A direct link to MedlinePlus, displaying additional information specific to this disorder
<singular>	This is a field to determine if language surrounding the particular disorder needs to be singular or plural... example "What is autism" vs. "What are dystonias"
<studiesLink>	A direct link to clinicaltrials.gov. For the link to work properly, add the disorder name to the end of http://clinicaltrials.gov/search/term=
<pubIndexLink>	A direct link to NINDS Publications about the disorder. For the link to work properly, add http://www.ninds.nih.gov to the beginning of the link
<graphicalURL>	A direct link to the XML display of the particular webpage for this disorder. For the link to work properly, add http://www.ninds.nih.gov to the beginning of the link
