## **Meeting Materials**

## **Submitting Comments on the Draft 2 Specifications**

Since discussion on key specification topics is continuing via the conference calls mentioned above, EPA has extended the deadline for submitting comments on the Draft 2 specifications until November 14, 2007. Please remember to reply to this message if you need access to CSA C380-06 to aid in your review. In our October 16 meeting, several participants noticed an error in one of the example equations in the presentation, which had been taken from the example equations in the specification itself. EPA thanks those who noticed this error, and has corrected the equation in the Draft 2 specification. The Draft 2 specification with the corrected equation highlighted on page 11 is attached for your reference.
