- Current FECA Benefit Structure is High and Discourages Claimant Return to Work (GAO 2001)
- ◆ Claimants Can Receive 3rd Party Reimbursements While Receiving Federal Salary During the 45 Day COP (GAO 2001)
- Savings Would be Realized if Permanent Disabled Moved to Retirement System (GAO 2001, USPS 2002)

Determine whether Federal employees are receiving FECA payments when wages were reported on SSA Master Earnings File
