## USCIS OFFICES IN WASHINGTON, D.C. TO CLOSE FOR TWO FEDERAL HOLIDAYS

**WASHINGTON**—U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) headquarters, field offices, asylum offices, and Application Support Centers (ASCs) in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area will be closed January 17 through January 20, 2009 for two federal holidays.

On Monday, January 19, all USCIS offices will be closed to observe the birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr. Because the federal holiday is on a Monday, all ASCs will also be closed on Saturday, January 17.

In addition, all USCIS offices in the District of Columbia, Montgomery and Prince George's Counties in Maryland, Arlington and Fairfax Counties in Virginia, and the cities of Alexandria and Falls Church in Virginia will be closed for the presidential inauguration on January 20.
