MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Paxson Communications Corporation ("Paxson"), by its attorney, hereby requests a one-week extension of time, until January 10, 2002, within which to respond to the oppositions to Paxson's petition to deny the above-referenced applications for transfer of control. Such oppositions were filed December 19, 2001 by National Broadcasting Company, Inc. ("NBC"), Telemundo Communications Group, Inc. ("Telemundo") and Council Tree Hispanic Broadcasters II, LLC ("Council Tree").

Under Sections 1.4 (g) and 1.45 (c) of the Commission's rules, Paxson's reply to the oppositions of NBC, Telemundo and Council Tree are due January 3, 2002. However, due to the intervening Christmas and New Year holidays, this will be insufficient time within which to study the oppositions and prepare a response. Lowell Paxson, Paxson's chairman, is traveling

out of the United States and will be unable to contribute to the replies until January 2. Further, Paxson's counsel's office will be closed December 24, December 25 and January 1. Under these circumstances, a one-week extension of time, until January 10, 2002 is needed and requested.

Counsel for NBC, Telemundo and Council Tree have been advised of the filing of this request.

WHEREFORE, It is hereby requested that the time for filing replies to the oppositions of NBC, Telemundo and Council Tree be extended to January 10, 2002.

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
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
