Dear Mr. Ball:

On behalf of Intelsat, Ltd., this letter is in response to your request for additional information, dated July 17, 2002, in connection with the above referenced applications.

1. Provide a post-transaction organizational chart showing Intelsat, Ltd. and the group of Intelsat companies.

The chart is attached as Exhibit 1.

2. (1) Clarify whether the shareholders' equity and voting rights are one and the same.

The equity interest of each shareholder of Intelsat, Ltd. is equivalent to that shareholder's voting interest.

(2) Clarify whether the shareholder from Armenia, the Ministry of Communications, is only 10% owned by the government of Armenia or whether this ownership is 100%. Additionally, please file a corrected Attachment 2 to reflect any changes or omissions, including the WTO status of Jordan.

The Ministry of Telecommunications of the Republic of Armenia is 100 percent owned by the government of Armenia. Attachment 2 to the Applications has been revised to reflect this correction. *See* Exhibit 2.

In addition, Attachment 2 has been revised to reflect the WTO status of Jordan as well as ownership changes since the Applications were filed. *See* Exhibit 2. Please note that as a result of a three-to-one consolidation of

Intelsat shares executed on June 4, 2002, the number of shares for each shareholder has changed since the Applications were filed. This consolidation has had no impact on the percentage of shares or votes held by individual shareholders.

3. Clarify whether the Applicants' calculation of WTO Ownership of Intelsat shares, stated to be 97.3 percent, counts those nations that are WTO Observers as owners. If the calculation includes these Observer nations as WTO owners, recalculate the percentage of WTO ownership based solely on Intelsat shareholders that have their principal place of business in countries that currently are WTO Members. If the resulting percentage is different than the ownership percentage at the time of the Intelsat LLC Licensing Order, explain the reason for the change in WTO ownership.

The statement in the Applications that "entities from WTO countries hold approximately 97.3 percent of Intelsat shares" is based on a calculation that includes both shareholders that have their principal place of business in WTO Member nations and shareholders with their principal place of business in nations that currently have WTO Observer status. Approximately 94 percent of Intelsat shareholders currently have their principal place of business in WTO Member nations.

As shown in Exhibit 3, the combined ownership interest of the entities in Intelsat, Ltd. that currently have WTO Observer status is approximately 3.7 percent, which approximates the difference between the percentage of shareholders in WTO Member countries (94 percent) and the WTO ownership percentage noted in the Applications (97.3 percent). The increase in WTO Member ownership since the *Intelsat Licensing Order* was issued nearly two years ago results from growth in the number of WTO Members as well as slight changes in shareholders' ownership percentages.

The remaining .40 percent discrepancy between the percentage noted in the Applications and the current WTO Member ownership percentage can be explained by the inclusion of the ownership interest of the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan (approximately .05%) and by minor changes in the ownership interests of various WTO Member and Observer entities.

4. Clarify whether any of the entities identified in Attachment 2 to the Application, other than Gambia, have become Intelsat shareholders since the *Intelsat Licensing Order*.

At the time of the August 8, 2000 *Intelsat Licensing Order*, Intelsat was an intergovernmental organization that did not have any shareholders. Intelsat has interpreted this question as asking for new shareholders since the July 18, 2001 privatization date. That information is reflected in the revised Attachment 2. *See* Exhibit 2.

5. Clarify the statement, at page 23, n.69 of Applicants' Opposition, that CWS no longer would be a "stand-alone unit once the proposed transaction closes except as a matter of corporate form." The Applications also state that Comsat's Title III licenses would be assigned to Intelsat LLC. Will CWS continue, post-transaction, as a separate unit of Intelsat LLC or of another entity in the Intelsat, Ltd. group of companies? If a separate unit, what would be CWS's functions? Will CWS or another entity handle all retail sales for CWS, including existing contracts and future sales? How will former "CWS sales, marketing and customer service expertise" be handled within the Intelsat structure?

CWS—currently an unincorporated business unit within COMSAT Corporation—will cease to exist upon the closing of the transaction. At that point, the existing CWS common carrier authorizations will move to Intelsat USA License Corp. ("License Corp."), a subsidiary of Intelsat USA Sales Corp. ("Sales Corp."). License Corp. will administer the common carriage services and outsource customer service, billing, and related functions to Sales Corp. Also at closing, the non-common carrier business operations of the former CWS will be absorbed by either Sales Corp. or Intelsat Global Service Corporation. Sales Corp. will employ all or substantially all of the former CWS sales staff who accept employment with Intelsat following the closing. The sales, marketing, and customer service expertise of the former CWS will be divided between Sales Corp. and Intelsat Global Service Corporation.

6. (1) Clarify what is meant by "similarly situated customers" as this term may apply to U.S. service providers and other customers.

An Intelsat customer deemed to be "similarly situated" to another customer for purposes of the Intelsat service agreements will be one who:

- (a) Generates revenues to Intelsat that are within the same quartile as the other customer—*i.e.*, a broadly similar revenue volume;
- (b) Has a business focus that is primarily located in the same geographic region as the other customer (including Global as one focus category); and
- (c) Has generated a similar growth profile on the Intelsat system in the period since privatization—(i.e., since July 18, 2001).

Based on the definition above, Intelsat would take into account the total amount of revenues the U.S. customers generate for Intelsat, the geographic locations where such customers use the Intelsat capacity, and the amount of growth in business that such customers have booked with Intelsat since July 18, 2001. These factors would be used to categorize the customer in a similarly situated group of customers for purposes of providing non-discriminatory treatment.

(2) How does such treatment compare with treatment given to former Intelsat Signatories?

When INTELSAT was an IGO, all of its customers, including former Signatories and direct access customers, were treated as equal regardless of the amount or geographic nature of business that they did with INTELSAT. This included providing the same rates, terms, and conditions across the board. Based on the use of the "similarly situated" standard, Intelsat is now able to vary offerings to customers by considering the factors indicated above in response to Question 6(1). While all customers may not have the same prices, terms, and conditions, all customers that fall in a similarly situated group will continue to obtain comparable treatment, regardless of their pre-privatization status.

(3) Do U.S. service providers and customers now have an opportunity to obtain available capacity from Intelsat pursuant to the terms of the Distribution Agreement ("DA") or Wholesale Agreement ("WA")?

As of the date of privatization, all Intelsat customers, including former direct access customers, that novated their services from the IGO to the privatized Intelsat group were extended the offer to enter into either the DA or WA. The FCC issued a public notice informing potential Intelsat customers of this offer. Today, as Intelsat continues as a private commercial entity, the company has developed a revised form of service agreement (including revisions to terms and conditions) offered to new customers of Intelsat as well as those pre-privatization customers that failed to enter into the DA or WA following privatization. Although the general terms may differ, the availability of, and ability to obtain, capacity is on the same basis as those customers that executed the DA or WA.

(4) For U.S. service providers and customers currently under contract with COMSAT for use of Intelsat space segment capacity, what would be their options for extending their use of that satellite capacity upon expiration of their contracts with COMSAT?

U.S. service providers and customers currently under contract with COMSAT will continue to have the ability to exercise any renewal or extension rights pursuant to their existing contracts. In addition, these customers will have the same right as any current Intelsat customer to negotiate new contracts, subject to the then-applicable terms and conditions offered by Intelsat for such services as well as the availability of the capacity. Any contract for new, renewed, or extended service would either be with License Corp. or Sales Corp.

(5) Will their continued use of that capacity be in jeopardy if it is not through COMSAT?

No. Current COMSAT customers will have the same opportunity to extend or renew their commitments as any other Intelsat customer. In addition, current COMSAT customers will have the same opportunity to obtain new capacity as other Intelsat customers, subject to availability based on Intelsat's global demand.

(6) How would their options compare with former Intelsat Signatories?

There is no distinction between the treatment of pre-privatization customers, including former Intelsat Signatories, and post-privatization customers. Subject to Intelsat's contractual rights to vary treatment of customers based on the similarly situated classifications, all Intelsat customers are treated the same regardless of their history with the IGO. Intelsat makes its decisions based on commercial considerations and not on the customer's Signatory/non-Signatory or pre-privatization/post-privatization status.

Intelsat, Ltd. Corporate Structure


