Dear Ms. Salas:

By letter dated September 21, 2000, OnePoint Communications clarified its then current wireless holdings, at the request of the agency staff. We now wish to provide an update to that report, indicating that OnePoint no longer holds any wireless licenses. All of OnePoint's remaining wireless licenses have now been assigned, with the consent of the Commission, to 21st Century Cable TV of Chicago, Inc.

- 1. The Commission granted an Assignment of Authorization for private microwave call sign WPQS217 to 21st Century (File No. 0000218082) on September 20, 2000; the Notice of Consummation for this assignment was filed on September 22, 2000.
- 2. The Commission granted OnePoint's last remaining application for a new station license on September 22, 2000, assigning the new station private microwave call sign WPQS718 (File No. 0000168834). OnePoint and 21st Century filed an application for Assignment of Authorization for this station on September 25, 2000 (File No. 0000225171). The Commission consented to that application on October 2, and the required Notice of Consummation was filed on October 3, 2000.

3. OnePoint's application for modification of license for call sign WPNB783 (File No. 0000168104) was granted by the Commission on September 28, 2000. The underlying license was previously assigned to 21st Century (File No. 0000180235), so the modification granted to this license is now in the name of 21st Century.

With the completion of these three items, all OnePoint's remaining licenses have been assigned to 21st Century, and OnePoint Communications Corp. no longer holds any radio license authorizations from the Commission.
