The purpose of this guide is to help you prepare and submit synopses of contract actions to the Commerce Business Daily (CBD). The CBD publishes the following types of procurement information:

- Proposed Contract Actions
- Contract Awards
- Sources Sought Notices
- Sales of Surplus Property

A new edition of the CBD is issued every business day. Each edition contains approximately 1,000 announcements. Each announcement appears in the CBD only once.

Commerce Business Daily (CBD) Publication Date Service

An electronic bulletin board service that provides contracting officers with the publication dates of their synopses. The service is free and available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

The service lists abstracts of CBD synopses by zip code groupings. Each abstract contains the first 300 textual characters of each synopsis.

All abstracts provided by the bulletin board are grouped by the contracting office's five digit zip code, see CBD Format Item #5 "Contracting Office Zip Code" or Format Item #7 "Contracting Office Address".

When a user accesses the bulletin board he or she will be required to enter their office's zip code. The bulletin board responds by providing a listing of abstracts of all synopses that contain that zip code from the CBD for the past ten workdays.
