PURPOSE: The purpose of this AAPD is to promulgate the attached FAR deviation to the requirements for preparation of SF 1420, Performance Evaluation (Construction), and SF 1421, Performance Evaluation (Architect-Engineer). Utilizing the NIH Contractor Performance System for the preparation of contractor performance reports on USAID's construction and architect-engineer contracts, as prescribed in AIDAR 742.1502 and ADS 302, will suffice in lieu of the FAR requirements to prepare SF 1420 and SF 1421.
