CONTRACT INFORMATION BULLETIN 92-22

This Contract Information Bulletin supersedes and cancels CIB 90-17. This CIB raises the dollar threshold for submission of copies of justifications for other than full and open competition to the Agency Competition Advocate from \$100,000 to \$250,000. The rationale for this change in reporting requirements is to reflect the class justification for other than full and open competition for overseas contracts of \$250,000 or less and contracts for personal services as provided in CIB92-5, pursuant to AIDAR 706.302-70(b) (1) and (2).

In order to meet reporting requirements under the Competition in Contracting Act, it is necessary that the Agency maintain a central record of justifications over \$250,000. Therefore, this CIB is being issued to require the Contracting Officer to submit a copy of the justification for other than full and open competition for any action over \$250,000 to the Agency Competition Advocate, FA/PPE, Room 1600I, SA-14.

This requirement is effective December 1, 1992 and will continue until cancelled.
