Chapter 153 - Indemnification of Employees, and Representation of Employees by the Department of Justice or Private Counsel at Government Expense

153.1 OVERVIEW

This chapter establishes policy and procedures for

- a. Indemnification of employees for personal liability for official acts; and
- b. Representation of employees by the Department of Justice or private counsel for acts within the scope of employment.

153.2 PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. The Assistant Administrator for the Bureau for Management (AA/M) has authority under the delegation in ADS 103.3.10.1 to decide requests for indemnification. **(See [ADS 103.3.10.1](#))**

153.3 POLICY AND PROCEDURES

153.3.1 Indemnification of Employees

The policy for indemnification of employees for personal liability for official acts is set forth in 22 CFR Part 207. **(See Mandatory Reference, [22 CFR Part 207](#))** Requests for indemnification are submitted to and decided by the AA/M or his or her delegate in consultation with the Office of the General Counsel.

153.3.2 Representation of Employees by the Department of Justice or Private Counsel at Government Expense

Employees who believe they are entitled to representation by the Department of Justice must submit their requests for representation to the Office of the General Counsel, Office of the Assistant General Counsel for Litigation and Enforcement (GC/LE). The procedures for such representation are found at 28 CFR § 50.15. **(See Mandatory Reference, [28 CFR Sec. 50.15](#))**

Under 28 CFR § 50.16, there are situations in which USAID may pay for private counsel. **(See Mandatory Reference, [28 CFR Sec. 50.16](#))** AA/M is authorized under the general delegation of authority in ADS 103.3.10.1 to decide whether or not to retain private counsel.
