USCIS NOTIFIES REFUGEE & ASYLEE APPLICANTS OF FILING CHANGES

USCIS designates two Service Centers to receive all I-730s

Washington, DC – U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) today announced changes to the filing procedure for Refugee and Asylee Relative Petitions (Form I-730). Until October 1, 2006, all I-730s were mailed directly to the Nebraska Service Center. As of October 1, individuals will file I-730s with either the Nebraska Service Center (NSC) or Texas Service Center (TSC). Petitioners can determine which filing location to use by viewing the I-730 web page, www.uscis.gov/graphics/formsfee/forms/i-730.htm, and on the instructions page(s) for the Form I-730. Please note that Form I-730 has undergone an extensive revision.
