SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

- **ITEM 1**. Enter the name, complete address and winery number of the applicant.
- ITEM 2. The class and type shall conform to one of the class and type designations in the regulations issued under the Federal Alcohol Administration Act. Wine products containing less than 7 percent alcohol by volume shall be designated in accordance with the labeling regulations of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act. Do not show a brand or fanciful name in item 2. Nonbeverage wine will be designated as such, since products are labeled under the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act.
- ITEM 3. If the product is to be bottled at more than one alcohol content within the same tax rate, state the alcoholic content as a range to include all alcoholic contents at which the product will be bottled.

- b. Identify flavoring or blending materials by the name of the flavor or blender, name of the flavor or blender manufacturer, the manufacturer's product number (if none, so indicate), drawback formula number (if none, so indicate), date of approval of the nonbeverage formula, alcohol content of the flavor or blender (if nonalcoholic, so indicate), a description of any coloring material contained in the flavor or blender.
