THEFT CALLED POTENTIAL DANGER TO THE PUBLIC

TOLEDO, Ohio — Kyle Walton, Resident Agent in Charge of the Toledo Field Office of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), and Lucas County Sheriff James A. Telb, Ph.D., today announced a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of those responsible for the March 27 burglary and theft of two machine guns and a silencer from a residence in Springfield Township, Ohio.

“These weapons in the hands of criminals pose a significant danger to the community and must be recovered,” said Walton.

“The potential danger to the public by this crime causes us to ask for the public’s help in solving it,” said Telb.

Anyone with information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the theft is urged to call 1-800-ATF-GUNS or Crime Stoppers at 419-255-1111. All calls will remain confidential.

Investigators from ATF and the Lucas County Sheriff’s Office are investigating this crime.
