WINNEBAGO COUNTY CRIME STOPPERS AND ATF ANNOUNCE \$3,500 REWARD FOR INFORMATION IN GUN DEALER THEFT

OSHKOSH, Wisc. -- The Winnebago CountyWide Crime Stoppers and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) announced today a reward of up to \$3,500 for information on a Nov. 14 burglary at Ron's Gun Shop in Black Wolf, Wisc.

The burglary at the federal firearms licensee, located at 5441 US Highway 45 South in Black Wolf, occurred at 1:30 a.m. when a witness heard an audible alarm and saw a possible suspect vehicle in the area. The vehicle is described as being similar to a 1980's Ford pickup truck, which appeared to be light in color, possibly red and white. The vehicle also had amber cab/clearance lights.

The following firearms were stolen in the burglary:

- Ruger P94 .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun
