RUSSELLVILLE MAN SENTENCED ON FIREARM CHARGES

David L. Huber, United States Attorney for the Western District of Kentucky, announced today that **CLIFTON STEVE CAULEY**, age 52, of Russellville, Kentucky, in Logan County, **was sentenced** in United States District Court, Bowling Green, Kentucky, for making a false statement in the acquisition of a firearm and being a felon in possession of a firearm.

Thomas B. Russell, Judge, United States District Court, sentenced **Cauley** to 2 years imprisonment, plus 3 years supervised release following incarceration. **There is no parole in the federal judicial system.**

Cauley plead guilty to knowingly possessing a firearm and providing a false statement to a gun dealer in order to re-acquire the firearm which had been pawned. **Cauley** stated that he was not a convicted felon when, in fact, he previously was convicted of the felony offenses of burglary, cultivation of marijuana, and complicity to promote contraband.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Randy Ream and was investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.
